The lymphatic system is comprised of a myriad delicate vessels that are dispersed throughout both the superficial and the deep tissues, a number of highly specialized glands, and even a small intestinal presence in the form of the central lacteal or chyliferous. They are appropriately named both for their characteristic colors and for their absorption functionality. The lymphatic vessels are found in almost every single tissue and system of the body that contains blood vessels. They perform a wide array of essential functions, including the transportation of nutrients from the small intestine into interstitial space, the removal of waste products from cellular metabolism into the blood, and the phagocytosis of infectious microorganisms. Because of this vast array of functionality, the lymphatic system is (and must be) considered a foundational aspect for the maintenance of optimal health. Without a fully functioning lymphatic system, our cardiovascular system would completely shut down and our immune system would be hopelessly damaged. All transportation throughout this network is not catalyzed by a continuous pump like the heart, but rather relies on the milking action of the active skeletal musculature, the pressure changes that occur during

diaphragmatic breathing, and the pulsations that occur as a result of arterial circulation. Because of the vast array of materials that are transported and phagocitized by this unpressurized circulating system, congestion of this system is very likely and is potentially very dangerous, as well.

Component Benefits:

Trifolium pratense (Red Clover) is an expectorant and antispasmodic that clears stagnation in the lymphatics and also relieves eczema, psoriasis, and respiratory congestion.

Stillingia Root primarily affects the lymphatic system and the excretory systems, thereby increasing drainage and limiting stagnation.

Prickly Ash Bark (Xanthoxylum clava-herculis) stimulates the circulatory and the lymphatic systems and is especially effective on mucous membranes.

Red Root (Ceanorthus) stimulates lymph and inter-tissue fluid circulation, thereby decreasing stagnation and improving tissue drainage.
